



## **Annual Report 2021**

Dear friends of solar cooking, donors and members of EG Solar e.V.,

like the year before, 2021 was also characterized by small and large challenges and our motto was based on the saying of Aristotle:

"We can't direct the wind, but we can adjust the sails."

Due to global restrictions caused by the pandemic, there were no major projects that we were able to implement last year, but there were many small ones that will continue to bear fruit in the years to come

- In March we delivered 100 sets of reflector sheets to the Paktia/Afghanistan region.
  An additional delivery is planned for 2022
- Schools in Germany and abroad expressed great interest in our solar cookers and wood-saving stoves
- Numerous educational institutions in Baden-Württemberg purchased a solar cooker from us
- We supplied TU Delft with 3 solar cookers for a project team
- A wood-saving stove was sent to a dual training facility in Tanzania via the "West German Chamber of Crafts and Skilled Trades"
- In the medium term, a solar cooker workshop is planned for Dareda, Tanzania, where we will closely work together with a former construction course participant
- A delivery of donated solar cookers to a children's home in Zimbabwe was organised and is to be executed within the next couple of weeks
- We have donated 20 solar lamps and solar modules to the Kara Tepe refugee camp on Lesvos
- We supplied many enthusiastic project partners not only in Germany, but also in Austria, Italy, France and, e.g. Costa Rica and Gambia with solar cookers and/or wood-saving stoves
- Last but not least, we were able to hold a construction course again in November
