At the end of July 2022 we received an inquiry by Mr. Teboho Thabane asking for 2-3 complete sets of reflector sheets which he wanted to purchase.




His personal aim is to help the trainees with skills that can help them start their own small workshops, and in his opinion solar technology offers the best option as a free energy especially now with the escalating prices of oil and scarcity of fire wood.

He also provided the following information:

"Lesotho, like all developing African countries is faced with high unemployment rate, and if somehow, we can have people with skills manufacturing solar cookers, dehydrators, water heaters etc. it can be a relieve. The biggest challenge is material resources as you can see from the photos attached, we have been able to create some useful working projects from locally found materials.

I have one working SK14 solar cooker at home. last month I made two cookers for somebody who had brought with her 2 sets from **Berlin**, this has generated so much interest from the students and the public alike."
